- 106 - 48 BC Pompey
- 66 BC - Asia Minor Becomes Cilicia, etc. See map
Tarsus the capital city of Cilicia
- 83 - 30 BC - Mark Antony; gave Roman Citizenship to all citizens in Tarsus
- 1 - 10 AD - Birth of Saul (Paul) in Tarsus
- 30 AD - Saul is student of Gamaliel in Jerusalem
Member of the Sanhedrin?
Married?
Rabbi (ordination at 40)?
- 36 AD - Death of Stephen
Pontius Pilate recalled to Rome
Marcellus replaces Pilate
Saul's vision on road to Damascus
- 37 AD - Saul in "Arabia"
- 37 - 40 AD - Saul in Damascus
Basket escape
- 40 AD - Saul goes to Jerusalem to see Peter; and has temple ecstasy
- 40 - 44 AD - Saul in Tarsus
- 45 AD - Barnabas goes to Antioch and brings Saul to Antioch
- 46 AD - Saul's "famine visit" to Jerusalem
Saul's ordination back in Antioch?
- 46 - 49 AD - Missionary Journey #1
Barnabas, Paul, and John Mark
Cyprus
Pisidian Antioch, Iconium, Lystra, and Derbe
- 49 AD - Council in Jerusalem
- 49 - 52 AD - Missionary Journey #2
- 53 - 58 AD - Missionary Journey #3
- 58 AD - Jerusalem
- 58 - 60 AD - Caesarea Maritima
- 60 - 61 AD - Voyage to Rome
- 61 - 63 AD - In Rome, house arrest
- 63 - 67 AD - To Spain? To the East?
- 67 AD - Arrest in Rome and beheading
