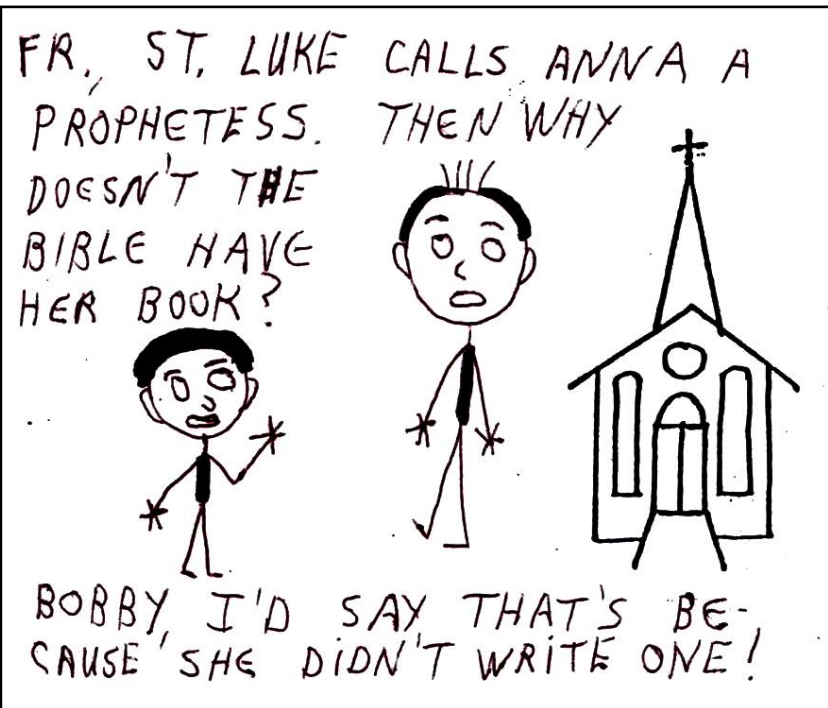
Words of Wisdom
