Across the world and especially in the rapidly growing Church in Africa and Asia, the young churches urgently need support... just as the Archdiocese of Cincinnati did upon its founding in the 1800s. 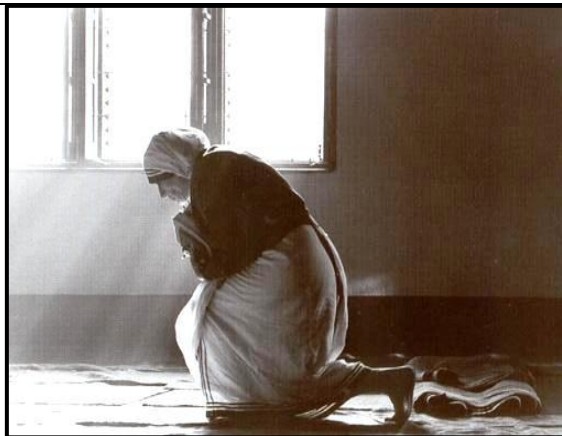
