Again, the generosity of all the people of St. Jerome's is overwhelming. We feel so extremely blessed to be a part of this wonderful community!

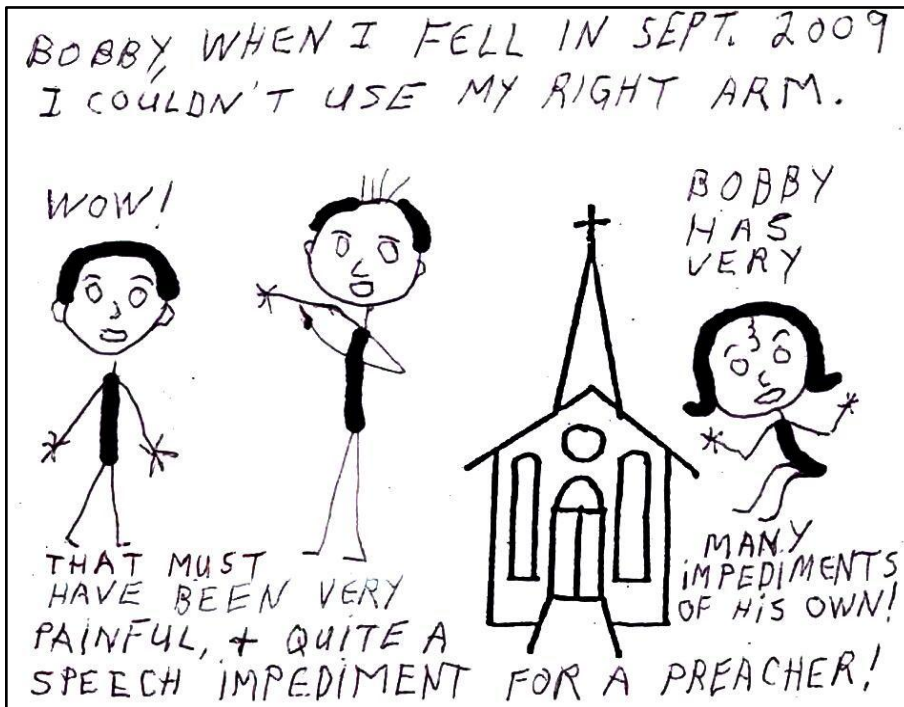
Words of Wisdom

Easter is not over! The Season of Easter runs from Easter Sunday until Pentecost (this year, June 12th). The people of St. Jerome's were blessed with exceptionally beautiful and uplifting Holy Week services this year and, fortunately, we can enjoy our celebration of the Lord's resurrection in the liturgy of the next 7 weeks. We will, of course, praise God for his gift of eternal life for the rest of our earthly lives and the rest of Easter should help us do exactly that.

Another wonderful experience which can add even more to your Easter celebration is the **Easter tide Vespers** which will be sung by the famous Athenaeum Chorale. If you've never attended Vespers with the Chorale, you should treat yourself to a very spiritual "shot in the arm". This starts at 7:30 PM in the Chapel of St. Gregory at the Athenaeum this Sunday May 1.

Please join us at St. Jerome Church during the month of May as we **honor Mary, the Mother of God**. On Tuesday, May 3rd, at 7:30 PM we will celebrate Mass followed by May Crowning of the statue of the Queen of Heaven. On all other Tuesdays during May (10th, 17th, 24th, and 30th) we will pray the Rosary at 7:30 PM before Mass.

You Have Questions; We Have Answers: May 1st is Divine Mercy Sunday. On February 22, 1931, Our Lord Jesus Christ appeared to Polish Sister Faustina (Helen Kowalska), bringing with Him a message of Mercy for all mankind. Saint Faustina tells us in her diary:

"In the evening, when I was in my cell, I became aware of the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand was raised in blessing, the other was touching the garment at the breast. From the opening of the garment at the breast there came forth two large rays, one red and the other pale. In silence I gazed intently at the Lord; my soul was overwhelmed with fear, but also with great joy. After a while Jesus said to me, 'paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the inscription: Jesus, I trust in You.'"

On May 23, 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina and declared that the Second Sunday of Easter be Divine Mercy Sunday and that the entire world should do penance and reflect on the Lord's saving grace.
