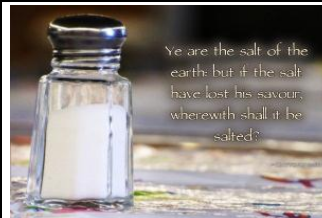

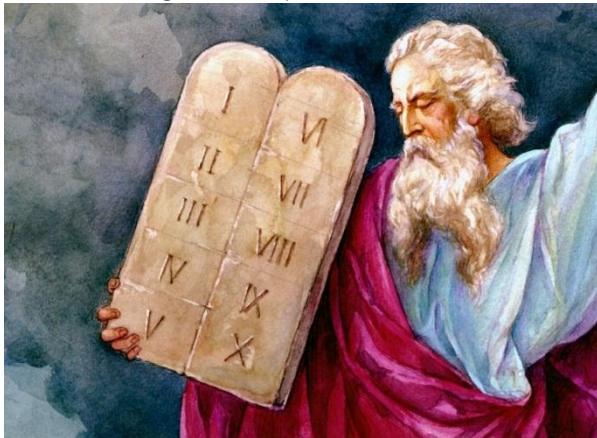

## You Have Questions; We Have Answers:



The sixth commandment is **You shall not commit adultery.** And the ninth commandment is **You shall not covet thy neighbor's wife.** Now we all know that Jesus taught that the marriage bed is sacred. The physical union, in marriage, between a **man and a woman**, is reserved as a very holy, natural, and human act. Any form of sexual activity outside that context is immoral.

Jesus also said, "...everyone who looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart" (Mt 5:28). Lust and sexual desire are very, very strong motivations and we all must ask God to help us control those urges. This law also applies to women as well as men, of course, thus, women must not covet their neighbor's husband, either.
