Paul and
Silas -- Member of the Jerusalem Church
Roman Citizen
Silvanus = Greek for Silas

Left Antioch
Through Syria, Cilicia (Tarsus) to Galatia:

Derbe
Lystra where Timothy joins Paul and Silas

Through Phrygia
To Northern Galatia: Pessinus?
Ancyra?
Tavium?

To Mysia: Troas where Luke joins Paul, Silas, and Timothy

Crossed over to Macedonia (Greece):
Neapolis
Philippi -- Paul exorcised a slave girl and was imprisoned and flogged
Thessalonica
Beroea
Athens
Corinth -- Paul stayed 18 months and lived with Aquila and Priscilla
Cenchreae
Ephesus
Caesarea Maritima
Jerusalem
Antioch (autumn 52 – spring 54 AD)
